TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 01 (APR 15): SEATTLE – BUENOS AIRES

Make your own way to your chosen airport for your international flight to Buenos Aires. Enjoy in-flight meals and services. Overnight Onboard Flight.

DAY 02 (APR 16): BUENOS AIRES (ARRIVAL)

Welcome to Argentina! Upon arrival in Buenos Aires, you will be met by our company representative and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day will be free at leisure. Overnight in Buenos Aires.

Optional: Dinner & Tango Show at Restaurant Viejo Almacén or Similar: USD 120 per person on SIC basis min 2 pax

DAY 03 (APR 17): BUENOS AIRES

(B/-/-)

Head on a guided half-day city tour of Buenos Aires. Begin your tour with a drive to the Plaza de Mayo — you will see the "Casa Rosada" (the pink house, home to the government), the Cabildo (town hall), and the Metropolitan Cathedral, home to the Archbishop of Buenos Aires. The tour will take you to the district of San Telmo, one of the most fashionable and desirable places to live in the city, and the famous La Boca neighborhood. Here, colorful tin houses and lively street life provide ample opportunities for photographs. Next, the tour will take you to Recoleta, the quarter of the rich in Buenos Aires. In Recoleta's cemetery, you can see the grave of Evita Perón, Argentina's former First Lady and the beloved heroine of the working class. Finally, you will head to Avenida 9 de Julio, the widest avenue in the world, the Federal Court of Justice in Plaza Lavalle, and Teatro Colón, before stopping at leafy Palermo where you can wander around the beautiful parks and gardens. From there you will return to the hotel.





DAY 04 (APR 18): BUENOS AIRES – IGUAZU (BY FLIGHT) (B/-/-)

In the morning you will be transferred to the domestic airport for your flight to Iguazu. Upon arrival in Iguazu, discover Iguassu Falls on the Argentinean side. Make a short stop at the Visitor's Centre and proceed along the Inferior Circuit, the down-river falls, to the Superior Circuit, the up-river cascades. The Ecological Jungle Train will lead you to the most impressive observation point in the falls — The Devil's Throat. After this visit, you will be transferred to the Brazilian side for overnight. Overnight in Iguassu on the Brazilian Side

DAY 05 (APR 19): IGUACU

(B/-/-)

Discover the Brazilian side of the falls with a motorcoach. Go along the paths following the cascades and along the catwalk, which will take you very close to the bottom of the Devil's Throat. Enjoy the breathtaking views from here. Afterwards, you can take an elevator back up to the road where you will meet your coach for your journey to the hotel for check in.

Overnight in Iguassu on the Brazilian Side



DAY 06 (APR 20): IGUASSU – RIO DE JANEIRO (BY FLIGHT) (B/-/-)

Prepare to be transferred to the airport in Iguassu for your flight to Rio de Janeiro. Upon arrival at the airport in Rio, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro

DAY 07 (APR 21): RIO DE JANEIRO

(B/-/-)

In the morning you will head on a tour of Rio. Downtown is the business heart of Rio; it is a part of the city where colonial Rio meets modern skyscrapers. Passing along Rio Branco Avenue, you will see Candelaria Church, which was built in the late 18th century and only completed in 1898. The headquarters of major Brazilian banks and commercial enterprises are also located on this avenue. You will also see the Opera House (Teatro Municipal) and Carioca Square, the Church of Santo Antonio built in the 17th century as well as the contrast of the modern buildings such as Petrobras and the Cathedral. You will see Rio's aqueduct built in the 18th century and these days connects the downtown to the Santa Teresa district, an old residential area. Afterwards, depart for a drive along the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon to reach the base of Corcovado. Take the small train to the top of the mountain and stand at the foot of one of the city's most iconic sights, the huge statue of Christ the Redeemer. From this vantage point enjoy breathtaking panoramic views over the city of Rio de Janeiro. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro



DAY 08 (APR 22): RIO DE JANEIRO - SANTIAGO (B/-/-)

In time take a flight to Santiago. Upon arrival in Santiago de Chile, you will be met by one of our representatives and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day will be at leisure for you to explore the city at your own pace.

DAY 09 (APR 23): SANTIAGO

(B/-/-)

Today you will head on a tour of the city to discover the famous landmarks of Santiago. This tour gives a complete panoramic view of the city beginning downtown at Plaza de la Constitución and La Moneda Presidential Palace, the current seat of the government. Driving through downtown-populated streets, you reach the important Plaza de Armas, heart of town since 1541. Around the square, there are located some important historical buildings such as the Central Post Office, the Cathedral, the City Hall and the National Historical Museum. Then you will pass by the Fine Arts Museum, a French Style building inaugurated in 1910 in the heart of Parque Forestal. Crossing the Mapocho River, reach the Bellavista bohemian neighbourhood and drive up to a viewpoint at the San Cristobal hill, a spur of the Andes Mountain marching into the city. With 340 m (1115 ft.) over the Plaza de Armas, it offers a wide panoramic view over Santiago. At the summit, a 36 m (118 ft.) tall statue of the Virgin looks down the city since 1908. Finally, you drive down the hill to visit uptown Santiago passing by some modern residential neighbourhood as Pedro de Valdivia Norte, Las Condes, and Vitacura. Return to the hotel

Overnight in Santiago

Optional: Wine Tasting and Aromas room at Undurraga Vineyard: Per person USD 199 based on min 2 pax

Discover the colonial house and spectacular gardens of one of the oldest vineyards in Chile and immerse yourself in some of the best wines on offer. Located only 45 minutes outside of Santiago, the Undurraga Vineyard is an unmissable spot for wine lovers. Founded in 1885 by Francisco Undurraga, it is one of the oldest vineyards in the country, complete with its underground wine cellars that date back to the XIX Century, and that still store their best wines today. The tour will take you to discover the colonial house, its cellars and the beautiful French style park, designed by the renowned landscape designer Pierre Dubois. Three of the Reserve wines will be part of the wine tasting session, while an expert will guide you on your discovery of the tastes and aromas of Chilean wine. Lasts 4 hours and departure at 09h00

Note: The city tour will be held in the afternoon from 3 pm onwards if guests opt for optional tour of Wine tasting at Undurraga.

DAY 10 (APR 24): SANTIAGO

(B/-/-)

A day at leisure to explore at your own pace in Saigon join us for an optional excursion. Overnight in Santiago

Optional: Full day excursion to Valparaiso and Vina Del Mar: Per person USD 210 based on min 2 pax

Time and duration: 0900 - 1700 hrs. (8 hrs.)

Valparaíso is known for its great artistic and bohemian scene, where students, foreigners, painters, poets and writers gather, inspired by the port and its secrets. Being thus a very cultural destination and heritage area, it stands out for its architecture, which instead of imposing itself, managed to adapt very well to the charming "chaos" of its hills. In addition, it forged its own surprising culture, where everyday life and details are obvious to anyone who walks through its passages.

DAY 11 (APR 26): SANTIAGO (DEPARTURE) – SEATTLE (B/-/-) Enjoy your day at leisure or book an optional tour. In the evening you will be transferred to Rio International Airport for your flight back home.
